*The Society welcomed the visit of **Pastora Daniela di Carlo**, the pastor of the **Waldensian/Methodist Church in Milan**, as the Delegate from the Waldensian Church to the General Assembly of the Church of Scotland, in May 2018. Pastora di Carlo took an active part in the Assembly, and spoke at an informal meeting, arranged jointly with the World Mission Group of **Liberton Kirk**, in **Liberton Kirk Centre, Kirkgate**, on **24 May 2018, at 7.30 pm**. We look forward to welcoming any Delegate to be sent for the 2019 Assembly.*

The Waldensian Tavola continues to support the significant work of **Mediterranean Hope**, the unified organisation of the Union of Reformed Churches in Italy, in assisting and settling migrants arriving in Italy. In particular, the Waldensian/Methodist Churches are active in supplying small-scale accommodation and training (e.g. in Italian Language), and have commitments to continued support in the area of Humanitarian Corridors. We now have a live link with **Mediterranean Hope**, with the work of a Scottish Lawyer, Fiona Kendall, now assisting in the office in Rome.
