The Waldensian Tavola continues to support the significant work of **Mediterranean Hope**, the unified organisation of the Union of Reformed Churches in Italy, in assisting and settling migrants arriving in Italy. This work is a practical response to the real European problem which will be with society for a considerable time. The website for further information is - www.mediterraneanhope.org. In particular, from a recent issue of the weekly Waldensian publication, "**Riforma**" (30 September), news was given of the use of the former Retirement Home in Vittoria, Sicily, which now houses 64 asylum seekers, along with the 34 Older residents, on the premises

It is proposed to organise a further **group visit** to Torre Pellice, for a 5 day visit in **October 2017.** This will include accommodation at the Foresteria in Torre Pellice, visits to the Waldensian Museum, Synod Hall and the historic sites in Val Pellice, and in Val d'Angrogna.
